### SUPPLEMENTARY AFFIDAVIT

I, the undersigned,

### **SEEHAAM SAMAAI**

do hereby make oath and state that:-

- I am the Director of the Women's Legal Centre ('WLC') based at 7<sup>th</sup> Floor, Constitution House, 124 Adderley Street in Cape Town. I am duly authorised to depose to this affidavit.
- 2. The facts contained herein are within my personal knowledge unless the context indicates otherwise, and are both true and correct. Where I rely on information conveyed to me by others, I verily believe same to be true.
- 3. The purpose of this affidavit is to supplement the submissions contained in our Founding Affidavit, dated 19 July 2018, in support of our application to be admitted as *amicus curiae*. This supplementary affidavit deals specifically with the correspondence of the Fifth Respondent, Cape Town Community Housing Company ("CTCHC") dated 13 July 2018, which we did not receive until Friday, 20 July 2018.



- 4. This affidavit will deal with two specific issues raised in the correspondence received from the attorneys representing CTCHC, namely:
  - 4.1. The lateness of the request for consent; and
  - 4.2. Whether the matter before Court raises an issue of gender.

### Lateness of our request for consent

- 5. On 12 July 2018 the WLC requested consent to enter the matter currently before the Court, as an *amicus curiae*, in terms of Rule 10 of the Constitutional Court Rules, from the attorneys for the first to twelfth applicants, the first respondent, and the fifth respondents. On 13 July 2018 we requested consent from the attorneys for the second to the fourth respondents. In the interests of avoiding any delays in the matter, WLC requested that written consent be provided by the parties by 13 July 2018.
- 6. On 13 and 16 July 2018 we received correspondence from the attorneys for the first to twelfth applicants, and the second to fourth respondents respectively, indicating their consent. We did not receive any correspondence from the fifth respondents.
- 7. On this basis we served and filed our application to be admitted with the Court on 19 and 20 July 2018 respectively, in which we indicated that we did not receive correspondence from the fifth respondents.
- 8. Subsequently, we were contacted by the attorneys for the applicants who enquired whether we had received the fifth respondent's correspondence on 13 July 2018, attached, marked annexure 'SS1'.
- 9. Upon our request the attorneys for the applicant forwarded the correspondence to me, marked annexure 'SS2'. This was the first time that I had received the correspondence. My candidate attorney, Harsha Zoë Gihwala, to whom the correspondence was also sent, also did not receive the email correspondence.



As a result, our main application does not address the issues raised by the fifth respondent, nor have we included the correspondence in our application.

- 10. Upon further investigation we were informed by our IT expert that the email was quarantined by our server, and was therefore not released into our inboxes. Attached at 'SS3' is an email from David Vaughan Mallinson informing us of the issue, as well as the Mail Quarantine Reports sent both to me and my candidate attorney, marked 'SS4'.
- 11. However, and notwithstanding the fifth respondent's objections to WLC being admitted as an *amicus curiae*, our application has dealt with the issue of lateness. WLC acknowledges that it remains the prerogative of the Court to decide whether our submissions will add value to the proceedings, and should therefore be admitted.
- 12. We submit that the parties will not suffer any prejudice should WLC be admitted as an *amicus curiae*, as we do not seek to place new evidence before the Court.

### Need for gendered lens

- 13. We submit that the submission made by the fifth respondent that the issue before the Court 'does not raise a gender issue' is incorrect. There are twelve applicants in the matter and the decision of the Court will impact on other families currently not before the Court and who are in a similar position as the Applicants.
- 14. Subsidies are only allocated to persons who are married or living with a long-term partner; or who are single or divorced, and with others who rely on their income. It is therefore clear that some of these households will be headed by women.
- 15. The aim of the WLC's intervention as an amicus in this matter is to place arguments before the Court that highlight the potential consequences of a

decision taken by the Court for individuals, specifically vulnerable women, who are not before the Court as applicants. We submit that the purpose of our arguments would be to ensure that the Court has before it arguments that advance the experiences of, and the wider societal impact on, those who will be affected by the Court's decision in this matter, in particular women.

- 16. In addition, this judgment will impact upon thousands of households who are currently, or will in future, enter into instalment sale agreements with the fifth respondents. These agreements will also relate to homes that vulnerable women live in, and are responsible for.
- 17. We submit that evictions are gendered by nature, and that they have a disproportionate impact on women and children who are left most vulnerable when their homes are taken away from them.
- 18. Gender neutral laws and policies that disproportionately impact on women need to be addressed. Our laws and policies must take into account, or make provision for, the intersectional forms of discrimination faced by women when they are evicted.
- 19. We therefore supplement our founding affidavit of 19 July 2018 in terms of the above, and pray that the Honourable Court grant the order in terms of the Notice of Motion.


