
AMICUS CURIAE

Having heard the Complainant and Respondent, and having read the documents filed of record:

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Allocation of Police Human Resources in the Western Cape unfairly discriminates against Black and poor People on the basis of race and poverty.
2. That the system employed by the South African Police Service to determine the allocation of Police Human Resources, in so far as it has been shown to be the case in the Western Cape Province, unfairly discriminates Against Black and poor people on the basis of race and poverty.
3. That the hearing on remedy is postponed to a date which shall be arranged with the parties.
4. That the costs are to stand over for later determination.
